Richmond Emmanuel Church reached a milestone in 2022 – purchased three units at the President Plaza as our future church site in the middle of the City of Richmond after so many years of fervent prayer. Financially, the next 20 months (January 2023 to October 2024) are critical to us since we still have to pay rent before our current lease term expires end of October 2024.

On the other hand, we successfully subleased part of our current location to two different parties: Makarios Institute for Spiritual Formation Ministries (MISF) and Wisdom Honor Education Ltd., thus offsetting some of our financial burden of paying rent to our current landlord and operating expenses and strata fee at the new location.

I still remember the late Archbishop Young Ping Chung once said "the best has yet to come". The Promise Land was given to Richmond Emmanuel Church in God's timing. There are lots of work waiting for us at President Plaza – a platform to spread the Gospel to the Richmond community.

For the first time, we organised a group of cycling children and families, youth and young adults in support of **Inner Hope Youth Ministries (IHYM)** through the Ride for Refuge. We were first connected with IHYM through Rev. Francis and Georgia who have both previously worked with this organisation. In our group, we had around 30 riders and walkers and we were able to raise over \$3700 of support!





Our yearly rhythm of supporting **Vancouver Urban Ministries'** Christmas hamper drive continued in 2022. VUM's director, David Innes, shared with us that these gifts have been a huge blessing to the kids and families, and have also created opportunities to show Christ's love and compassion to those who have never heard of Jesus!

      - We have an accepted offer on the President Plaza and development committee is reviewing the documents and have also invited a building inspector to look at the units. We should look at what God has given us and give thanks. We know our current rental contract does not allow for early termination and it is difficult to rent out our current space. The landlord recently agreed to allow us to rent out the youth center space,

contingent on us paying property tax. The landlord also did not outright say no when we asked if we could terminate our rental contract early. Dr Li has also agreed to lend us \$1 million but the interest free period is now extended to April of 2024.

The parking lot has leaking issues that is the responsibility of the strata council. There are dry water marks in the units, but it seems to have been fixed. The power supply is also enough for church use. There are new and old plumping heaters, so the recommendation is to replace them soon. The air conditioning and heaters also have new and old units so we can replace the old ones soon as well. The report has been given to the development committee.
  - I want to thank Jacky's operation team for the past year with all the leakage. I also want to thank the reopening team. I also want to thank Dionne's worship team for their adaptability to COVID restrictions.
